

2024 CIMF Concerto Competition Rules

- 1. The 2024 CIMF Concerto Competition will take place on Saturday, May 19, 2023 at a location to be confirmed in Ridgefield, CT. To participate, a **completed application must be submitted by Monday, April 22, 2024 for participation in the competition, as well as a \$15 application fee.** Applications should be emailed to <u>cimf@wctyo.org</u> or submitted via the online application.
- 2. The participants will be assigned a performance time in the afternoon of May 18th, between 2-6 pm. Please check your calendar before you submit your application to be aware of possible conflicts with the competition date!
- **3.** Music to be performed must be approved by CIMF Artistic Director and Orchestra Director. Maximum time length of a piece or movement of a concerto played for the competition is 15 minutes.
- **4.** Piano accompaniment (for instruments other than piano) is required for the competition and participants are responsible for obtaining their own accompanist.
- 5. Musicians playing works from the standard repertoire from the 19th century or earlier must have their music memorized for the competition. Exceptions will be made on a case-by-case basis by request. Musicians playing concertos from the 20th century or later do not need to memorize their music, but are encouraged to do so. - 6. Participants should arrive at the competition location 30 minutes prior to their assigned performance time to warm-up. Participants who arrive late and are not ready to perform at their assigned time will be skipped and will be allowed to perform at the end of the competition if time allows.
- **7.** The CIMF Concerto Competition winner will appear as soloist with the CIMF Orchestra in concert on Thursday, August 8, 2024 during the summer festival.
- 8. The decision of the judges with respect to a winner is final.
