The mission of the **Charles Ives Music Festival** is to honor the legacy of Charles Ives by bringing American music to the Fairfield County regional area, a community that is home to one of America's most famous composers. CIMF concerts regularly feature dynamic and unique artists performing the works of Charles Ives, the music of 20th and 21st-century American composers, and music that transcends the traditional boundaries of classical music to incorporate other styles of music.

CIMF artist-faculty and guest artists come from leading American orchestras and ensembles, including the New York Philharmonic, the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra, and the Dallas and Baltimore Symphony Orchestras. They also perform on Broadway, in chamber ensembles, and as concert soloists. In recent years, CIMF has brought GRAMMY-winning musicians to the festival including double bassists Edgar Meyer and Ranaan Meyer, violinist Charles Yang, and composer Kevin Puts.

CIMF also provides interactive and innovative educational programs, centered around the exploration of chamber music, for youth musicians. CIMF Artist-Faculty not only perform in the Artist Concert Series, but rehearse and perform in additional concerts with the youth musicians who participate in the CIMF summer program.
